COMPETITION RULES 2025

TEAM REGISTRATION STARTS AT 9.30am AT THE DESIGNATED REGISTRATION POINT. MANAGERS MEETING 9:00AM!

The First Touch FC Summer Slam 2025 tournament age groups are based on the 2024/25 season.

- 1. Players to be under the appropriate age on September 1st 2024
- 2. 6 aside teams shall consist of a squad of maximum TEN players
- 3. Players may only play for one team.
- 4. Any team found to be playing over age players shall be disqualified.
- 5. Each age group to be run initially on a league basis then on a knock out basis Champions League & Europa League.
- 6. League points to be awarded as: Win = 3 Draw = 1
- 7. Should two teams be level on points and goal difference, the team scoring the highest number of goals shall be placed highest, otherwise a penalty shoot-out will decide.
- 8. Winning team manager to take scorecard to central score point.
- 9. Game times as follows (all games straight through NO Half times)
 - a) Under 8's 12 mins No Heading / Kick ins Dribble ins
 - b) Under 9's 12 mins No Heading / Kick ins Dribble ins
 - c) Under 10's 12 mins No Heading / Kick ins Dribble ins
 - d) Under 11's 12 mins No Heading / Kick ins Dribble ins
 - e) Under 12's 12 mins No Heading / Kick ins Dribble ins
- 10. Quarter / Semi-finals in each competition shall be on a knock-out basis.
- 11. If no result in a Quarter / Semi-final and/or Final then penalties shall decide, leading on to sudden death in equal number of attempts after initial 5 kicks.
- 12. Trainers or boots may be worn.
- 13. Shin guards MUST be worn by all players.
- 14. Under 8s to Under 10s age group rules of play shall be in accordance with Mini-soccer, please note the following:

- A. Players must be a minimum of 5 yards away from the ball at free kicks, corners and kick ins/dribble ins.
- B. All free kicks are direct.
- C. Goalkeepers are allowed outside of their goal area, but cannot pick up the ball.
- D. Goalkeepers can kick the ball out.
- E. Goalkeepers are not allowed to pick the ball up from a back pass.
- F. When the ball goes behind the goal line, the goalkeeper must restart the game with a goal kick
- G. Outfield players are allowed inside the goal area.
- H. No Offside Rule.
- I. Halfway line to be used as a retreat line at goal kicks (up to and including U10's)-opposition players must stay in their half until keeper plays the ball-this does not stop a keeper taking a quick goal kick if required.
- J. NO HEADING UPTO & INCLUDING UNDER 10's.

15. Under 11's are as Mini Soccer, with the following exceptions:

- A. No half way retreat line in operation. However opposition players to leave the area for Goalkicks
- B. Throw ins rather than kick ins/dribble ins

16. Under 12's are as Mini Soccer, with the following exceptions:

- A. Heading is permitted
- B. No half way retreat line in operation. However opposition players to leave the area for Goalkicks
- C. Throw ins rather than kick ins/dribble ins
- 17. The referees decision on the field of play is final.
- 18. Competitions executive committee decisions are final and irreversible.
- 19. NO ALCOHOL allowed to be removed from the Haworth Park bar area All alcohol must be consumed within the bar area.
- 20. NO ACADEMY PLAYERS (Academy = A player not allowed to play / register for a Grassroots team).
- 21. In the unfortunate event that the event should be cancelled due to weather we will not be able to offere refunds of the tournament fee.
